- i) The petitioner would undertake to vacate the premises in dispute on or before 31.03.2019. He shall file an undertaking to this effect before the Executing Court/Rent Controller on or before 30.04.2018.*
- ii) In consideration for this, the respondents agree to waive off all arrears of rent and future rent.*

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
