On April 04, 2018, this Court had passed the following order:-

“As per office report, neither the correct address of respondent No.1 has been filed nor CM for impleading the LRs of deceased respondent No.4 has been filed.

Let fresh notice be issued to respondent No.1 for 10.08.2018 through ordinary process, registered cover and dasti as well on furnishing of correct address, requisite number of copies of the paperbook, registered cover, process fee and incidental expenses, if any, within four weeks.

In the meanwhile, steps be also taken to implead the LRs of deceased respondent No.4.

In case of non-compliance of this order in its letter and spirit, this petition shall be dismissed for want of prosecution.”

As per office report, no application has been filed by learned
counsel for the petitioner to implead LRs of deceased respondent No.4.

In view of the above fact as also afore-quoted peremptory order passed by this Court, this petition is ordered to be dismissed for non-prosecution.
