Heard.

Petitioner is not satisfied with the impugned order dated 20.2.2018 (Annexure-P-5), passed by the learned District Judge, Patiala, whereby his case has been transferred from one Court to another Court at Nabha. Petitioner seeks transfer of cases i.e. CS-1215-2015, titled as Beant Kaur and another Versus Darshan Singh and CS-201-2016, titled as Sandeep Singh and others Versus Darshan Singh and others (Annexure-P-1 and AnnexureP-2 respectively) outside the jurisdiction of Nabha Courts. The only allegation is that respondent No. 1, a young lawyer, who belongs to Nabha Bar Association is threatening petitioner. The mere fact that respondent No. 1 is a member of Nabha Bar Association is not a ground to presume that he is in a position to influence the local Judges. Regarding threat made by respondent No. 1 to petitioner, no ground is made at this stage to transfer the cases

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outside the jurisdiction of Nabha Courts. However, if some subsequent events take place, the petitioner is always at liberty to take the matter to learned District Judge, Patiala, to shift the cases outside Nabha Courts. Consequently, revision is dismissed.
