Landlord is in the revision petition. It is not disputed that a fresh eviction proceedings were initiated against the tenant, which was allowed and appeal and revision has already been dismissed.

However, if the order passed in the connected revision petition is challenged or reversed, petitioner would be at liberty to move an application for revival.
