This revision has been filed against the concurrent orders of the Courts below allowing ejectment of the petitioner-tenant from the demised premises.

On instructions from his client the learned counsel for the petitioner has stated that the petitioner will not press this petition on merits and will vacate the premises voluntarily on or before 30.9.2018 without forcing the respondent to file/press an execution petition and will continue to pay the rent in advance alongwith other admissible charges regularly.

Mr. Ranjan Lohan, Advocate appears for the respondent and after taking instructions from the respondents has also accepted this offer on the condition that the petitioner will file an undertaking to the above effect and deposits the entire arrears and the future rent upto 30.09.2018 before the

Executing Court/Trial Court on or before 15.5.2018, failing which, this revision should be deemed to be dismissed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has accepted this condition.

In the circumstances, the revision petition is disposed of in the above terms, subject to the deposit all arrears and future rent alongwith undertaking on or before 15.5.2018.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
