This order shall dispose of the above mentioned Civil Revision No. 2557 of 2013 and COCP No. 2798 of 2013. Civil Revision No. 2557 of 2013 has been filed against the concurrent orders of the Courts below whereby the application filed by the petitioner-plaintiffs for the grant of ad interim injunction has been allowed. COCP No. 2798 of 2013 has been filed by the petitioner-defendants for proceeding against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act for not complying with the order of this Court dated 09.05.2013 whereby parties were directed to maintain status quo.

Mr.Amitabh Tewari, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent submits that as per the instructions from his client, the aforementioned petitions have become infructuous since the suit has now been decided.
