AMOL RATTAN SINGH, J. (ORAL)

As already recorded in the order dated 10.08.2018, on 25.07.2018 the following order had been passed:-

“The only issue in this revision petition is as to whether the entire amount as was due to the respondent in terms of the compensation awarded to him for acquisition of his land, has been paid by the petitioner Union of India, or something still remains to be paid, with the learned executing Court having held vide the impugned order that it had “got verified calculations and as per the verification an amount of Rs.79,241/- is still remained unpaid to the decree holders”.

However, no calculation sheets or any further explanation has been given by that Court as to how the aforesaid amount was due to the respondent.

Learned counsel for the petitioner would place on record the final compensation awarded up to the last Court, to the respondent, to determine as to whether it has been paid or

not.

He would also place on record a copy of the decree that is sought to be executed.

Since the issue involved is seemingly only a arithmetical problem, adjourned to 10.08.2018.

On 10.08.2018, learned counsel for the petitioners (Union of India) had sought time to comply with the aforesaid order.

Today, even almost 04 months after the order of July 25, 2018, the order has not been complied with.

It already having been made clear that the petition would be deemed to have been dismissed-in-default if the order is not complied with, today a request for an adjournment is still made on behalf of learned counsel appearing for the petitioners. Consequently, the order dated 10.08.2018 becomes operative, with the petition dismissed-in-default.
