INDER SINGH VS P.O.C.G.I.T. & ORS.

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Present: None.

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The workman aggrieved by the award of the learned Industrial Tribunal-cum-Labour Court, Chandigarh filed the present writ petition and prayed that the award be quashed and it be declared that the petitioner is entitled to reinstatement with future rights for career progression.

The matter came up before the Lok Adalat on 09.02.2018. Mr. Jai Gopal Verma, counsel for the petitioner did not put in appearance, whereas Mr. P.N. Arora, counsel for respondents No.2 to 4 was stated to have died. It was in these circumstances, notice was ordered to be issued to the petitioner as also to respondent No.3.

It has now been reported that notice issued to the petitioner has been received back unserved with the report that the petitioner has since died on 10.03.2010, his Legal Representatives have not been brought on record during the last 8 years.

None has put in appearance on behalf of the respondents.

Keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has expired on 10.03.2010 and his LRs have not been brought on record, no useful purpose is served to keep the writ petition alive; the same is ordered to be consigned to the record. Liberty is, however, granted to the LRs to get it revived, in case of need, by moving an appropriate application.
