The present civil revision petition has been filed for setting aside the order dated 13.02.2017 (Annexure P-5), passed by learned Civil Judge (Jr. Divn.), Ludhiana, vide which, the application filed by the petitioner/defendant, under Order 7 Rule 11 CPC, for rejection of plaint has been dismissed.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the revision petition against the order passed on application filed under Order 7 Rule 11 CPC. The only prayer is that in terms of the agreement, the possession has been delivered to the respondent-plaintiff. It is stated that the petitioner is an old lady and remaining amount is not being paid and merely injunction is sought. Therefore, the trial Court may be directed to decide the case expeditiously.

In view of the above request, the present civil revision petition is dismissed as withdrawn with a direction to the trial Court to decide the case expeditiously, preferably within a period of six months.

At the time of arguments before the trial Court, the petitioner can raise all the pleas available to him.

Since the main revision is dismissed, therefore, pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, shall also stand disposed of.
