The petitioner has impugned the order dated 05.05.2008 passed by Additional District Judge, Ropar, Executing Court vide which the State was directed to pay a total sum of ₹6,80,197/-.

Heard.

It comes out that the State was ex-parte before the Additional District Judge, Ropar, Executing Court. Before the Executing Court both the parties had filed their statement of account. Only difference was of income tax, which considered by the Court and the remaining amount was calculated and ordered to be paid.

The State has informed that the amount has already been deposited. There is no illegality and infirmity in the impugned order dated 05.05.2008.
