Through this application under Section 151 CPC filed by the
appellant, prayer has been made for preponment of the main revision petition.

Allowed as prayed for.

Main petition is preponed for today from 16.08.2018.

C.R. No.2471 of 2018

Through this petition under Article 227 of the Constitution of India,
challenge has been laid to order dated 27.02.2018 of the trial Court, whereby
evidence of the petitioner-plaintiff has been closed by Court order.

Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that in the
interest of justice, a single opportunity may be given to the petitioner-plaintiff to
examine only himself, subject to payment of costs.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, in the interest of
justice, equity, good conscience and fair play, the impugned order is set aside.

Resultantly, the petitioner-plaintiff is granted one opportunity to examine only

himself on the next date of hearing i.e. 29.05.2018 before the trial Court, subject to payment of costs of ₹10,000/-, to be deposited with the Member Secretary, District Legal Services Authority, Rupnagar. In case, the cost is not paid, this revision shall stand automatically dismissed.

This petition is disposed of without issuing notice to the respondents with a view to impart justice to the parties and to save the huge expenses which may be incurred by the respondents and also to avoid unnecessary delay in the adjudication of the matter. Still, if dissatisfied, the respondents may move this Court for recalling this order within six weeks from today.
