Impugned in present revision is order dated 6.3.2018, passed by learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), Jalandhar, vide which pending disposal of petition filed under Section 9 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, interim maintenance at the rate of Rs. 3,000/- per month has been allowed on the application filed under Section 24 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955.

The learned counsel for petitioner contends that petitioner is getting salary of Rs. 5,500/- as per income detail. However, it is observed that minimum wages in State of Punjab are not less than Rs. 8,000/- per month. In any situation, Rs. 3,000/- per month cannot be called excessive in view of level of prices of essential commodities. There is no ground to interfere in impugned order. Consequently, petition is dismissed.
