Impugned in present revision is order dated 23.5.2017 (Annexure-P-1), passed by learned Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Faridkot, vide which an application filed by respondent under Order XXXIII Rule 1 CPC, 1908, for suing him as indigent person was allowed.

Heard.

It comes out that in this case, issues were framed. The report of Collector was called for and it came out that applicant respondent has only one residential house in which he is living. He is not drawing any income from same. Respondent produced bank account which shows that for the period of about three years and three months, a sum of more than Rs. 1,00,000/- was deposited and now only balance left is little more than Rs. 12,000/-. Trial Court after recording the evidence has found that respondent applicant does not have sufficient means to pay the Court fee. There is nothing on file to show that applicant has got means to pay court fee. There is no ground to interfere in impugned order.

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Consequently, revision is dismissed.
