1. Challenge is to order dated 22.03.2018 (Annexure P-1), passed by the learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Ambala (hereinafter referred to as 'the learned lower Court') issuing warrants of possession for 30.05.2018.

2. A perusal of the impugned order reveals that the learned lower Court dismissed the application for stay and issued warrant of possession for 30.05.2018, after taking into account the prayer for adjourning the execution petition *sine-die* in view of the petitioner having invoked the jurisdiction of Hon'ble the Supreme Court where the case was tentatively listed on 17.05.2018 and there being no stay with regard to execution petition.

3. After filing the revision petition, the matter was got adjourned on 24.04.2018, 21.05.2018, 29.05.2018, 18.07.2018, 27.08.2018 and 05.09.2018. However, till date order, if any, passed by Hon'ble the Supreme Court has not been placed on record. Besides, none was present

for the petitioner either on 05.09.2018 nor for that matter today, despite the case having been called out twice.

4. In the light of the position as noted above, I do not find any circumstances warranting interference with the order passed by the learned lower Court.

5. Finding no merit in the revision petition, the same is dismissed.
