After arguing for some time and on instructions from their
respective client, the counsel are agreed to the following order:-

“It has been agreed that the petitioner shall hand over vacant possession of the premises in dispute to the respondent on or before 31.10.2019. In consideration for that the respondent has agreed to give up all the arrears of rent and future rent upto 31.10.2019 but the counsel for the respondent has prayed that the petitioner should file an undertaking before the Rent Controller on or before 16.07.2018 to the effect that he would vacate the premises in dispute on or before 31.10.2019. Counsel for the petitioner has accepted this condition.”

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
