Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that objections under Section 34 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996, filed by the respondents are pending adjudication before the learned Additional District Judge, Chandigarh, since last four years causing harm to the petitioner for the reason that he is not able to meet out his day-to-day expenses and continue his business on account of non-receipt of awarded amount.

Perusal of file shows that after passing of the award, respondent No.1 filed objections in May, 2014 and since then around 4 years have passed and nothing fruitful has been done for deciding the same by the Lower Court.

Considering the over all facts and circumstances, learned Additional District Judge, Chandigarh, is directed to decide the objections within four months positively.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
