I am of the view that it was wrong on the part of the plaintiff to file objection in an application for passing of the final decree. Plaintiff can only file the reply in which he can raise objections then it is for the trial Court to frame the issues, if necessary and decide the same after recording the evidence. Therefore, the objections are misconceived and were rightly

dismissed. However, the plaintiff-petitioner is given liberty to file reply and raise objections, if any, to the drawing of the final decree.

The trial Court after recording the evidence shall decide the same without taking into consideration the order dated 21.2.2018 (Annexure P-4), passed by learned Civil Judge, Junior Division, Ferozepur, rejecting the objections.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with above direction.
