This is the tenants revision petition against the order of ejectment. However, today learned counsel for the petitioner has furnished an undertaking to vacate and hand over the vacant possession of half of the ground floor, half basement and entire back ancillary portion of SCO No.32, Sector 11, Panchkula to the landlord/respondents No.1 to 3 positively on or before 15.7.2018 and that in view of the said undertaking, the revision petition may be dismissed.

The learned counsel representing the landlords has submitted that the aforesaid arrangement is acceptable to the landlords.

In view of the aforesaid undertaking, the revision petition is dismissed as withdrawn with a direction to the tenants to comply with the undertaking and to vacate the premises in question by 15.7.2018.
