After arguing for some time learned Senior Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has been earning his livelihood from the premises in dispute for more than three and a half decades and in case the respondent is willing to allow the petitioner to stay till 31.12.2018, he would not press this petition on merits. Counsel for the respondent has also very fairly stated that he would have no objection but in that case the petitioner should file an undertaking within one month with the executing Court to the effect that he shall hand over the possession on or before 31.12.2018 and will deposit the up to date arrears of rent within one month and will also deposit monthly rent in advance on 7th of every month. Counsel for the petitioner has accepted these terms.

In the circumstances, petition stands disposed of in the above mentioned terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending C.M, if any, also stand disposed of.
