By way of the present petition, the petitioner seeks issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing the B-1 test held in Police District Barnala on 31.05.2003 wherein the petitioner was not permitted to participate in spite of the fact that he had duly applied for the same and he was fully eligible as per the provisions of Rule 13.7 of the Punjab Police Rules.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has not responded to the repeated communications sent to him.

Learned State counsel, on instructions states that the petitioner has telephonically informed that he has been promoted as Assistant Sub Inspector, therefore, he is not interested in pursuing the matter.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.

However, as the order is being passed without the assistance of learned counsel for the petitioner, in case, the petitioner feels that the grouse raised in the petition still survives, he shall be at liberty to revive the present petition without three months from today.
