GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J.

By way of filing this revision petition, the petitioner-tenant challenges judgment dated 15.9.2017 passed by the learned Appellate Authority, Amritsar whereby an order of ejectment passed by learned Rent Controller, Amritsar has been affirmed.

After arguing at length, learned counsel for the petitioners, on instructions from the petitioners who is present in Court has submitted that he does not press upon the revision petition, and that some reasonable time may be afforded to petitioners to vacate the premises in question.

In view of the aforesaid submission, the revision petition is disposed of by enlarging the time for vacating the demised premises and by issuing a direction to the petitioners to hand over vacant possession of the demised premises by 31.3.2019 subject to the condition that all the arrears of

rent/mesne profits of the demised premises are duly paid and he continues to pay rent/mesne profits regularly in future. Petitioners are also directed to furnish an undertaking to this effect before the learned Rent Controller, Amritsar within three weeks, from today.
