With the assistance of Ms.Aarti Gupta, Advocate, a compromise has been effected between the parties. As per terms of the compromise, tenant will vacate the demised premises on or before 31.01.2020 and hand over the vacant possession to the respondent-landlord. Balbir Kaur-petitioner No.1 has given her undertaking that her daughter Rajbir Kaur-petitioner No.5 is married and does not reside in the said premises. Amandeep Singh- petitioner No.2 has given his consent to his mother i.e. Petitioner No.1 for vacation of the said premises. Keeping in view the abovesaid settlement, the petitioners i.e. Balbir kaur, Amandeep Singh, Karanbir Singh and Kamaljit Kaur shall be given their undertaking to the Rent Controller, Gurdaspur on or before 18.06.2018 with regard to settlement/agreement.

In view of the above factual position, the present revision is dismissed. Parties shall be bound with the terms and conditions of the compromise.
