The instant petition has been filed under Article 227 of Constitution of India for issuance of directions to Ld. Civil Judge, (Junior Division), Ludhiana to decide application filed under Order 39 Rules 1 and 2 read with 151 CPC for grant of ad interim stay till the decision of the suit and further to struck off the defence of the respondent/defendant as no written statement has been filed till date.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that said application under Order 39 Rules 1 and 2 read with 151 CPC is pending before the lower Court since 19.09.2017. All opposite parties have already appeared, but they have not filed the written statement and asking for adjournments. He requests that the Civil Judge, (Junior Division), Ludhiana be directed to decide said application expeditiously.

As the application is pending since 19.09.2017, therefore, the lower Court is directed to decide the said application under Order 39 Rules 1 and 2 read with 151 CPC expeditiously, preferably, within 2 months.
