Concededly, the injunction granted by the trial court to the petitioner-plaintiff had since been reversed by the appellate court vide order dated 2.5.2013. Although, notice of motion was issued by this Court on May 31, 2013, but the interim prayer for injunction was declined for the time being, as the court below had found that the plaintiff had failed to establish even a prima facie case.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as there has been no interim protection nearly for the past five years, and in all likelihood even the suit might have been decided by the trial court. Thus, he submits that nothing substantive survives in this petition and the same be disposed of, as such.

That being so, the petition is disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous.
