Main Case

Impugned in the present revision petition is the order dated 13.10.2017 (Annexure P-5), vide which pending the disposal of a petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, learned Addl. District Judge, Patiala while disposing of the application filed under Section 24 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, granted maintenance @ ₹6,500/- per month to the respondent and her two children from the date of filing of the application and ₹3,000/- as litigation expenses were also allowed.

Heard.

After going through the impugned order, I am of the view that the maintenance granted by the learned Addl. District Judge, Patiala, is already on the lower side. It is very difficult now-a-days to maintain a

family of two children with ₹6,500/- per month. Therefore, there is no ground to interfere in the impugned order.

As such, the present petition is dismissed.
