Learned counsel requests for some more time to comply with the orders passed by this Court on 18.05.2018. A perusal of the order reveals that the petitioner fairly admitted that in fact ₹ 20 lakhs were borrowed by him from the respondent in the year 2012 and at the time of motion hearing he had offered to refund ₹ 20 lakhs to the respondent along with reasonable rate of interest. Thereupon this Court vide order dated 18.05.2018 directed the petitioner to deposit a lump sum amount of ₹ 35.00 lakhs before the Executing Court in two equal installments of ₹ 17.50 lakhs each i.e. first within two months from date of order and the second one within next two months. It was further mentioned that in case of failure of the petitioner to comply with the order, the petition would be deemed to

have been automatically dismissed for want of prosecution. Since it is the stand of the petitioner that the order has not been complied with, therefore no further time can be granted. Accordingly request for extension of time is declined and in terms of order dated 18.05.2018 the petition is dismissed for want of prosecution.
