Impugned in the present revision petition is the order dated 16.2.2018 (Anenxure P-5) passed by learned Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Jagraon vide which an application filed under Section 24 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 was allowed and the respondent-wife was awarded interim maintenance of Rs. 2500/- per month including to litigation expenses from the date of filing of the application.

Heard.

I am of the view that maintenance @ Rs. 2500/- per month including litigation expenses awarded by the trial Court to wife-respondent is already inadequate. Therefore, this is no ground to interfere in the order dated 16.2.2018 (Anenxure P-5) passed by learned Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Jagraon.
