Defendant-petitioner is in the revision petition against the order passed by the learned trial Court allowing the application for amendment of the plaint so as to add property number. Learned trial Court has found that such amendment is neither going to change the nature of the suit nor is going to cause any prejudice to the rights of the defendant. The Court has recorded that the same is essential in order to make out identification of the property clearly.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, although very seriously contested the revision petition, however, taking into consideration that only one property number has been allowed to be added in the suit for possession which according to the learned trial Court is essential in order to identify the property in dispute, this Court does not find any good ground to interfere with the order passed by the learned trial Court.

Revision petition is dismissed.
