Learned counsel for respondent No. 1 submits that respondent No. 1 will pay the entire amount of house tax as claimed and due till date with interest and costs before the Rent Controller.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the revision petitioner has no objection if the revision petition be disposed of on these terms.

Parties are directed to appear before the Rent Controller on 16.04.2018. The petitioner will give the entire details of the house tax due till date before the Rent Controller. The Rent Controller will assess the interest and costs on this amount and allow one opportunity to respondent

No. 1 to pay the same.

In the event of house tax with interest and costs as assessed by the Rent Controller being not paid, learned Rent Controller may pass the order as per law in the ejectment petition.

This petition stands disposed of in above terms.
