i) *The petitioner would vacate the premises in dispute on
or before 31.07.2019. He shall file an undertaking to this
effect before the Executing Court/Rent Controller on or*

before 28.09.2018.

ii) In consideration for this, the respondent agree to waive off all arrears of rent and future rent.

In case the petitioner fails to vacate the premises on the agreed date or file an undertaking, this petition would liable to be dismissed.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
