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KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

Impugned in present revision is order dated 2.4.2018 (Annexure-P-4), passed by learned Additional District Judge, Amritsar, in which pending divorce petition filed by respondent wife, maintenance at the rate of Rs. 1,000/- per month to wife, maintenance at the rate of Rs. 1,000/- per month to unmarried daughter and litigation expenses at the rate of Rs. 1,500/- have been allowed.

Heard.

It is contended that petitioner is unable to earn and therefore, he is unable to pay monthly maintenance allowed to wife and unmarried daughter.

I am of the view that there is nothing on file to show that respondent is suffering from serious ailments. Even if he works as a labourer, he can easily pay Rs. 2,000/- per month to his wife and unmarried daughter. It being so, there is no ground to interfere in impugned order. Consequently, revision is dismissed.
