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Pursuant to the order dated September 26, 2018, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has got the entire ream of documents as are contended to be illegible, due to which (as contended) the petitioner could not file his written statement on time before the trial Court.

Mr. Sanjay Majithia, learned Senior counsel for the respondents, submits that in any case the documents which have already been submitted by the respondents-plaintiffs before the trial Court, can't be any better than that what they are, and therefore, to ensure that a speedy trial is conducted by the trial Court, the respondents are ready to pay the cost of photocopying the said documents as the petitioner seeks legible copies of.

That being so, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the trial Court that the documents referred to in the application dated 22.8.2017 filed by the petitioner herein, would be permitted to be photocopied by the petitioner in the presence of the respondents-plaintiffs, with the respondent-plaintiffs to foot the bill for such photocopying.

Mr. Sanjay Majithia, learned Senior Advocate has in fact handed over a sum of ₹500/- to learned counsel for the petitioner for that purpose. Obviously, if the bill is beyond ₹500/-, the respondents-plaintiff would make good the same and if the same would be below ₹500/-, the balance would be refunded to the respondent.

After the needful is done (on the same day that the documents are handed over for such photocopying), the petitioner would file his written statement within 2 weeks thereafter, before 29.10.2018.
