This order will dispose of CR Nos.3869 and 3894 of 2018 filed with a limited prayer for issuing directions to the executing Court to decide the execution expeditiously.

Counsel for the petitioner would inform that objection petition under Order 21 Rules 97 to 99 read with Section 151 CPC has been filed on behalf of Didar Singh – objector to which the petitioner – decree holder has already filed the reply. It is further submitted that eviction order passed against Tilak Raj in May 2015 has attained finality upto this Court but till

today the petitioner is not successful to recover possession of the demised premises.

Without commenting upon merits of the case or objection petition preferred by Didar Singh, the petitions stand disposed of with a direction to the Court below to ensure that objector does not delay the proceedings by getting unnecessary adjournments.
