By this petition, the petitioner seeks early disposal of the petition filed by him under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, before the learned Judge, Family Court, Jalandhar, on 23.02.2016, the contention being that even after the petitioner had submitted his affidavit by way of his examination-in-chief on 13.10.2017, counsel for the respondent (wife) has sought unnecessary adjournments from time to time, deferring cross-examination of the petitioners' witnesses for no good reason.

This petition is consequently disposed of with a direction to the trial Court to ensure that unnecessary adjournments are not granted to the respondent, with even adjournment sought on the ground of ill health etc., to be scrutinised carefully, and an adjournment granted only where it is genuine needed; and the trial concluded expeditiously.
