This revision has been filed against the concurrent judgments of the Courts below dismissing a petition for eviction filed by the petitioner.

The case set up in the eviction petition was that the petitioner wanted to shift to the premises in dispute (flat in Jalandhar) for residential purposes. However, during the case, the petitioner changed her stand and led evidence to prove that she required the premises in dispute for setting up a beauty parlour. To my mind, this change of stand dis-entitles the petitioner. Consequently, finding no merit this petition is dismissed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending C.Ms, if any, also stand disposed of.
