The defendant is in revision against the order dated 11.05.2017 as also the order dated 19.05.2017, vide which, the respondent-plaintiff was permitted to examine an hand-writing expert in support of his claim. Concededly, pursuant to impugned orders hand-writing expert namely Sunil Verma has already been examined and the petitioner has since cross-examined the said witness as well. And, the matter is now posted for final arguments.

In this view of the matter, no ground is made out to interfere in exercise of revisional jurisdiction under Article 227 of the Constitution of India. The petition is accordingly disposed of. Parties through their respective counsel shall appear before the trial Court on the date already fixed. Needless to assert that the stay order dated 25.09.2017, shall stand vacated.
