Judgment-debtors are in the revision petition against the order dated 06.05.2017 issuing arrest warrants against the judgment-debtors No.1 and 3. Learned trial Court has observed that the judgment-debtors have executed a sale deed in favour of Sukhcharan Kaur in order to cheat the interest of the creditors.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has placed on record copy of the sale deed in favour of Sukhcharan Kaur. The aforesaid sale deed has been executed by Sh. Surjit Singh who is judgment-debtor No.2 whereas the arrest warrants have ordered to be issued against judgment-debtors No.1 and 3.

Taking into consideration the aforesaid facts, the order under challenge is set aside. Learned Executing Court is directed to re-decide the matter after re-examining the facts available on the file.

Petitioners through their counsel are directed to appear before the learned Executing Court on 21.03.2018.

Revision petition is allowed.
