Undoubtedly, the witness which the petitioner now wishes to summon was not an originally listed witness before evidence of the petitioner-plaintiff was closed, vide the impugned order dated 14.05.2018.

On specific query, learned counsel submits that the petitioner-plaintiff does not wish to examine any of the remaining witnesses from the original list of witnesses submitted before the learned Civil Judge seized of the suit.

That being so, for production of any other witness, obviously an appropriate application would have to be moved by the plaintiff-plaintiff, which would be decided on its own merits.

When this Court had observed as above, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition, with liberty to file an application before that c Court.

Dismissed as withdrawn, with that liberty in any case always available to the petitioner.

However, it is made clear that if any such application is moved by the petitioner-plaintiff, the same would be decided wholly on its own merits.
