Plaintiff-petitioner is in the revision petition against the order passed by the learned trial Court directing the plaintiff to affix ad valorem Court fee.

This issue has been conclusively decided by the Full Bench of this Court in the judgment reported as Niranjan Kaur Vs. Nirbigan Kaur, 1981, PLJ 423.
