Both the learned counsel for the parties are *ad idem* for disposal of the Revision Petition in the following manner.

1. On setting aside of the *ex parte* judgment and decree dated 25.02.2011, petitioner-defendant shall deposit the entire decretal amount along with interest before the learned trial Court within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
2. On deposit, the decree-holder respondent-plaintiff shall move an application for withdrawal which shall be allowed subject to the undertaking in shape of adequate surety.
3. Parties shall be given three effective opportunities to lead evidence.
4. The trial of the suit shall be completed within a period of one year. Trial Court shall be circumspect in case either of the parties makes any attempt to delay the adjudication of the trial.

In view of the above, Revision Petition stands disposed of.
