This order of mine shall disposed of two revisions petitions bearing **CR No.4511 of 2017** titled as **“Hari Chand V/s Mukesh Kumar”** and **CR No.4516 of 2017** titled as **“Hari Chand V/s Jai Singh and another”**, arising out of the dismissal of the applications for consolidation

of two suits.
