Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that after the order dated July 18, 2018 was passed by this Court, the Commissioner, Patiala Division has decided the revision petition filed by the petitioner before him, on 30.11.2018 and as such this petition has been rendered infructuous.

However, he submits that a copy of the said order has still not been available to the parties.

It is to be noticed that learned counsel appearing for respondent no.1 also does not deny the aforesaid fact.

This petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous, with a direction to the Commissioner, Patiala Division, Patiala, to ensure that a copy of the order passed by him, dismissing the aforesaid revision petition of the petitioner is made available to the parties within a period of 10 days from today.

In view of the fact that despite 17 days having been gone by, a copy of the order passed by the Commissioner is not available, even though this petition has been disposed of as having been rendered infructuous, the interim order dated July 18, 2018, directing the Assistant Collector 1st Grade, Khamanon, not to pass the final order in the partition proceedings, shall continue to enure for a period of 20 days from today, further subject to a copy of the order passed by the Commissioner being given to the parties within 10 days.
