AMOL RATTAN SINGH, J.(ORAL)

By this petition, the petitioner (defendant no.1 in the suit) challenges the order dated 31.05.2018 passed by the learned Additional District Judge, Ludhiana (appellate Court), by which the appeal of respondent no.1-plaintiff has been allowed, thereby granting him interim injunction against alienation of the suit property during the pendency of the suit.

Though learned counsel for the petitioner has addressed arguments on the merits of the case with regard to the power of attorney executed by the petitioner having been cancelled etc., without going into that issue in any manner whatsoever, the injunction granted only being with regard to further alienation of the suit property, I see no reason to entertain this petition.

However, while dismissing it, it is observed that such dismissal will not be interpreted in any manner by the learned Civil Judge or in any

subsequent proceedings, to be any inference taken by this Court as regards

the merits of the case of the parties, which would naturally be adjudicated upon wholly on the basis of evidence led.
