**RAJ MOHAN SINGH, J. (Oral)**

This revision petition has been preferred against the orders dated 26.02.2018 and 21.04.2018 passed by the Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.) Amritsar, whereby the objections filed by the petitioners in Execution Application were dismissed and warrants of attachment have been issued.

On 23.07.2018 while issuing notice of motion, this petition was ordered be heard along with Civil Revision No.3567 of 2018.

At the time of issuance of notice of motion in

CR No.3567 of 2018, the contention of learned counsel for the petitioners was that the entire principle amount has already been paid in view of terms and conditions of the compromise, but there was a default in making payment of interest on delayed payment.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that now interest on the delayed payment has also been paid to the decree-holder(s).

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent admitted the aforesaid position.

In view of consensus arrived at between the parties, no further action is called for in the present revision petition. The execution petition has also been withdrawn by the decree-holder(s) being fully satisfied. Consequently, this revision petition is disposed of.
