This revision petition has been filed by the petitioners impugning the order dated 05.03.2018 passed by learned Additional District Judge, Faridabad whereby the objections of the petitioners in the execution petition were dismissed.

In a claim petition filed by the respondents, learned Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Faridabad passed an award dated 31.10.2013 as per which the respondents were awarded compensation of Rs.2,19,500/-. On receipt of full and final payment as per award, the execution petition, which was filed by the respondents, was withdrawn by them and being fully satisfied on 02.05.2015. Thereafter, FAO No. 8423 of 2014 filed by the respondents for enhancement of compensation was decided in their favour by this Court on 09.02.2016 and the compensation was enhanced to Rs.5,00,000/-. The respondents filed second execution application claiming the additional amount of Rs.3,00,000/-. The petitioners herein filed objections to the same contending that the second execution application was not maintainable, which has been dismissed vide the impugned order.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioners.

I find no merit in the present revision petition. Earlier execution application was in respect of the award of learned MACT and the same having been satisfied, was got dismissed as withdrawn. Thereafter as the amount has been enhanced in appeal filed by the respondents, the second execution application was filed. Learned counsel could not point out as to how the second execution application was not maintainable.
