Petitioner has prayed for issuance of necessary directions to the Addl. District Judge, Jalandhar to conclude the trial of matrimonial case No.693/2017 titled 'Hardeep Kumar vs. Monica' within a reasonable time.

By referring to Section 21-B(2) of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that every petition under this Act shall be tried as expeditiously as possible and an endeavour should be made to conclude the trial within a period of six months from the date of notice of the petition on the respondent. Respondent has already appeared

in the trial Court in the month of June 2017.

Learned counsel on behalf of the petitioner undertakes that the petitioner's evidence would be concluded positively within a period of three months.

The factual details on record have not been denied by learned counsel for the respondent.

Keeping in view the aforesaid, legal position, I deem it appropriate to accept the prayer of the petitioner and allow the present revision petition. Trial Court is directed to make every endeavour to decide the pending matrimonial *lis* between the parties at the earliest by giving short adjournments preferably within a period of six months.
