Through the present petition challenge is made to the order dated 09.05.2018 passed by the Civil Judge (Junior Division), Dasuya (for short – 'the trial court'), dismissing the application filed by the petitioner for appointment of Local Commissioner to visit the spot in question and to submit a report after demarcating the suit land.

The trial Court has rejected the afore-application on the ground that it is not the job of the Court to appoint a Local Commissioner to adduce the evidence for the petitioner, rather, it is the petitioner who has to prove his case by leading cogent and permissible evidence. The trial Court has further opined that even otherwise, the report of the Local Commissioner would not help the petitioner to prove the facts which the petitioner can prove by leading evidence.

No error is found in the impugned order.
