Ms.Devaki Anand Sullar, learned Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, on instructions from ASI Hardip Singh PS Haryana, District Hoshiarpur, submits that in pursuance to the order dated 12.3.2018 bailable warrants issued against Sandeep Singh received un-executed with the report that he is residing abroad.

Mr.Surinder Thakur, learned counsel, on instructions from the power attorney holder, seeks withdrawal of CR No.4937 of 2017.

Mr.Deepak Verma, learned counsel for the petitioner in CR No.7840 of

2017 opposes the withdrawal of the revision petition on the premise that the husband is in arrears of maintenance.

CR No.7840 of 2017 has been filed for enhancement of the maintenance pendente lite from ₹10,000/- to ₹50,000/- per month. Concededly, the divorce petition has been filed by Sandeep Singh through power of attorney. The dispute is between the husband and wife. In my view, Amandeep Kaur petitioner in CR No.7840 of 2017 has a remedy to seek dismissal of the divorce petition for non-compliance of the maintenance pendente lite.

Accordingly, I dispose of CR No.7840 of 2017 filed by the wife with liberty to move an appropriate application.

In view of the statement made by Mr.Surinder Thakur, Advocate, CR No.4937 of 2017 is permitted to be withdrawn.
