Heard.

Petitioners-defendants have impugned order dated 4.1.2018 (AnnexureP-6), passed by learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Moga, vide which their application for additional evidence was dismissed.

It comes out from the impugned order that a suit was filed in the year 2011 and that petitioners-defendants availed as many as 22 opportunities to conclude their evidence. On 23.5.2017, petitioners-defendants closed the evidence. The case was ripe when on 1.8.2017 petitioners-defendants moved an application for additional evidence and same was allowed. The said additional evidence was led and petitioners-defendants closed the evidence on 16.10.2017. Again when the case was ripe and was fixed for arguments, another application for additional evidence was filed on 7.11.2017 stating that Jaswant Singh, who is Namberdar of village, is required to be produced.

I am of the view that petitioners-defendants have been granted

a large number of opportunities numbering in 22. Even their earlier application for leading additional evidence was allowed, in which it was not claimed that Jaswant Singh, Namberdar of village, is required to be produced. It comes out that when case becomes ripe, an application for additional evidence was filed. This is a ploy to delay the disposal of suit. There is no ground to interfere in the impugned order. Instant revision is dismissed.
