After arguing this case for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw this revision petition on the ground that both the Courts below dismissed the petition under Order 21 Rule 32 CPC on the ground that the petition was discrepant with regard to disclosing material particulars in terms of date, time and manner of alleged violation of the decree.

Learned counsel seeks withdrawal of the present revision petition with a prayer that right of the petitioner be kept intact in case of any future violation of the decree.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

It is made clear that the present order shall not be read as an instance to give rise to any fresh cause of action in relation to present violation as alleged by the decree holder in the present revision petition, however, in case of any violation of decree in future, the petitioner may resort to her legal remedies in accordance with law.
